 Garden waste


 Nappies

Dispose of food waste **ONLY** in a green bag and tie it well.



## CARDBOARD, PAPER AND PLASTIC



Paper, news-  
papers/  
catalogues

Cardboard boxes

Milk-/  
juice boxes

Envelopes

Plastic bags

Plastic packaging  
from meat, fish,  
fruits, vegeta-  
bles and spreads

Crisp bags

Plastic jugs/  
plastic containers


Flower pots

Plastic bottles

Polystyrene

Cardboard and paper  
should be thrown in  
the blue bin

Plastic packaging  
should be rinsed  
with cold water  
and disposed of in a  
transparent plastic  
bag. The bag  
is collected  
every 6 weeks.

cat sand should be wrapped properly

Non-recyclable waste is what is left  
after you have sorted as much as possi-  
ble. Should be put in a regular bag.
